UGA Mission Statement

- The University of Georgia, a land-grant and sea-grant university with statewide commitments and responsibilities, is the state's oldest, most comprehensive, and most diversified institution of higher education. Overview of Alumni Chapters

- UGA Alumni Chapters exist to connect alumni, promote the University of Georgia and the UGA
 Alumni Association around the world, and to strengthen ties between alumni and their communities
 - Managing an alumni chapter is a big responsibility and requires the efforts of multiple volunteers to be truly successful
- Chapter Distinctions
 - Champion Chapter (staff-identified)
 - Varsity Chapter
- Distinctions are determined during the annual Chapter Recognition Process

Chapter Recognition Process

- Chapter Recognition occurs annually
 - Submissions open April/May
 - Submission deadline of June 30
- Completing the Chapter Recognition Process is required for all Champion and Varsity Chapters
- Includes a Chapter Application, Memorandums of Understanding (MOU) from each alumni volunteer,
 and completed Chapter Leader Onboarding Modules from each new alumni volunteer
- Champion Chapters are required to submit an **Annual Plan** detailing the events they wish to hold throughout the upcoming year
 - Plans will be reviewed and approved by staff

Chapter Application

- The Chapter Application and Memorandum of Understanding are sent through a Chapter Leader Update email from staff
- In the Chapter Application, you will:
 - Identify the chapter as either a Champion Chapter or Varsity Chapter (staff-identified)
 - · List the alumni volunteers serving on your board
 - Report on the previous year's events, successes, and opportunities
 - List goals for the coming year
 - List the chapter's social media accounts

Memorandum of Understanding

- The Memorandum of Understanding outlines the expectations of a Chapter Leader, including agreements to:
 - Carry out the UGA Alumni Association mission
 - Fulfill the expectations of a Varsity or Champion Chapter
 - Represent UGA and the Alumni Association in a professional and respectful manner
 - Appropriate and responsible use of access to both listserv communication and alumni data
 - Maintain the activity of the chapter's social media pages
 - Assist in the transition of the next chapter leadership
 - Commit to raise funds for the Alumni Association Scholarship and/or UGA Foundation
 - Make an annual gift to a UGA cause
- MOUs are submitted annually for each alumni volunteer

Annual Plan

- Champion Chapters are required to submit an Annual Plan each year, while it is highly encouraged of Varsity Chapters
- An Annual Plan is a calendar of events for the fiscal year



Overview of Events

- Champion Chapters
 - Host 2 to 4 volunteer-led events per year (exclusive of nationwide programming)
 - Minimum of 2 events
 - Maximum of 4 events
- Varsity Chapters
 - Host 1 to 2 volunteer-led events per year (exclusive of nationwide programming)
 - Minimum of 1 event
 - Maximum of 2 events
- Chapter events and Nationwide Programming will be discussed in greater detail in Module 4
