WHAT IS THE UGA **MENTOR PROGRAM?**



MENTEE **EXPECTATIONS**



drive the mentoring relationship--have a clear sense of your intentions for the relationship



connect at least once per month



establish goals with your mentor



express gratitude









be considerate and respectful of time and schedules

do not ask for an internship or job

MENTOR **EXPECTATIONS**



commit to the relationship for the full 16 weeks/one-time quick chat



routinely connect/interact with mentee and ask great questions



guide mentee to develop goals and provide feedback along the way



help set clear ground rules: confidentiality, judgement free zone, define intended outcomes









let us know if/when you need support/resources

6 be vulnerable and transparent


