

SAC | FAQ HOW TO APPLY

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What is SAC?

The Student Alumni Council (SAC) is a board of student volunteers who hosts events to connect students with alumni, celebrate university traditions, and encourage students to give back to areas on campus that matter most to you.

How can I join SAC?

Applications for SAC open October 1st every year and close at the end of the month. Each applicant must submit a completed application to participate in the group interview process. Group interview sign-up times are available throughout the month of October at the front desk of the Alumni Association office (Wray-Nicholson House located at 298 S. Hull St., on the northwest edge of campus). At the conclusion of the group interview process, select applicants will be invited for an individual interview. After the individual interview process, candidates will receive membership decisions prior to the Thanksgiving holiday. Accepted applicants will officially be membership in SAC at the start of the spring semester with an orientation and General Body Meeting (GBM) every Tuesday of the semester. All orientations and meetings are mandatory for membership in SAC.

What is in the application?

Each year, the SAC Membership Committee updates the application questions; however, you should prepare to connect your experiences to SAC's priorities, such as UGA traditions, alumni engagement, or student philanthropy. You are encouraged to draw from skills and experiences that are and are not present on your resume.

What does a group interview look like?

In the group interview SAC, a group of up to four students (including yourself) will be given a prompt and asked to work together to develop a response. Afterwards, each candidate will have the opportunity to answer specific questions based on their contributions and experience.

What happens in an individual interview?

The individual interview take place in front of a panel of student and Alumni Association staff and volunteers, and is an opportunity for you to highlight the skills that you could bring to SAC. Successful interviewers have provided concrete examples of servant leadership and connected examples to the application materials.

What else can I do to prepare?

Before applying to the Student Alumni Council, we strongly suggest that you take some time to learn what we are all about. To learn more about SAC, you should consider:

- Attending an information session
- Connecting with current SAC members and asking them about their experience as a volunteer board member
