Patmos, Greece

Known as the "Jerusalem of the Aegean," Patmos is a traditional Greek island that is both beautiful and highly spiritual. Exiled here in A.D. 95, St. John the Divine wrote the Book of Revelations while residing in the Cave of the Apocalypse. The 11th-century Monastery of St. John was built in his honor.

Haifa/Jerusalem, Israel

Perched atop Mt. Carmel and claiming one of the most beautiful gardens in the world, Haifa is truly stunning. To the south lies Jerusalem, boasting over 3,000 years of history and considered the holiest city on earth for Jews, Christians, and Muslims.

Limassol, Cyprus

Known locally as Lemesos, Limassol offers an alluring backdrop of centuries-old ruins, lemon and olive groves, majestic mountains, and stunning beaches.

Rhodes, Greece

Home to an ancient acropolis, whitewashed towns, and the medieval walled city known as Rhodes Town, the island also boasts incredible scenery, dreamy beaches, and an average of more than 300 days of sunshine each year.

Ephesus/Kusadasi, Turkey

The port of Kusadasi, until recently a fishing and farming village, is today a resort town offering splendid beaches and plenty of shops. Nearby is the legendary ruined city of Ephesus, a veritable museum of Greek and Roman history.

Mykonos, Greece

Amid the shimmering waters of the Mediterranean is the heart and soul of the Cyclades: Mykonos. Situated on an island of the same name, the town artfully balances glitz, glamour, and classic Greek culture with its labyrinth of cobblestone streets and chalk-white houses beside bluedomed churches.
